**Mid-point Update to the Ten Year Plan to Address Homelessness**  
**Snapshot: Milestones to Date – April 3, 2017**

**Scanning the Landscape Survey**

Conducted Scanning the Landscape survey with 168 community members participating. See Assessment Results Recap.

**Communication Platform**

As a part of the HOAC communication platform, developed website, set up the FB page, and established official listserv to increase transparency of the HOAC and the mid-point update process.

**Comprehensive Data Report**

Epidemiologist compiled data from available sources and followed up with key organizations to harvest pertinent local data regarding housing and homelessness.

**Community Partner Inventory Mapping**

Continue to update the community partner map as process progresses, and used to help identify key informants. See Community Partner Mapping.

**Key Informant Interviews**

Conducted 39 interviews and 8 group discussions between November 2016 and present with additional interviews scheduled in April. Incorporated preliminary themes into Scanning the Landscape survey results. See Key Informant Interview List.

**Engage Persons with Lived Experience**

- **Part 1:** Benton County Health Services staff incorporated questions into routine interactions with clients and additional outreach efforts with 123 community members participating (Harm Reduction: 97, ACT Team: 19, Mental Health & Housing: 4). See Special Population Input (Adults).
- **Part 2:** Garfield School Neighborhood Assessment survey (n = 300), Youth group discussion, Veterans group discussion, Monroe Food Pantry survey, Health Navigation survey (English, Spanish, Arabic).

Input from persons with lived experience (special populations) to be incorporated in to the draft Action Plan.

**Draft Action Plan**

Drafted Goals and Strategies for the mid-point update using input from Scanning the Landscape survey and Key Informant Interviews, and updated based on HOAC feedback. See Updated Draft Goals & Strategies.
